

DISTRICT MONTHLY REPORT: MAY 2017

ADMINISTRATIVE:

- 1) On May 17th, Chief VanCamp and legal counsel Tom Burke met with mediator Judge Tom McPhee in Seattle regarding the settlement of claims from contractor OSG for the District Training Center project.
- 2) At the May 9th regularly scheduled Board meeting, Commissioner Small presented a proposal on the District hosting a Federal grant application for community risk assessment. The Fire Chief and District Secretary (with clerical staff) would provide overhead support to the project as part of the required funding-share requirement; there would be minimal impact on workload for District staff.

- 2) District personnel underwent annual recertification of their wildland firefighter "red-card" status during the month.

PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT, RELATIONS:

- 1) Chief VanCamp attended the annual Association of Washington Cities Labor Relations Institute in Yakima on May 3 through 5.
- 2) Chiefs VanCamp, LeMay and Kilpatrick met with Shelley Westall, program manager with Washington One-Net (the statewide public safety wireless network project) about recording District personnel participating in live-fire training and other activities as part of their educational presentation process. Production technicians were on site at the Mark Noble Regional Training Center on May 20th.

EQUIPMENT & FACILITIES:

- 1) Apparatus & Equipment:
 - a. Engine-81: on 18 May, Lt Graham met with Chief Mechanic Larry Elliot and representatives from Pierce regarding issues: windshield wipers, wire-less head-sets, bell location when leaning cab down, compression brake, paint finish, moisture in storage cabinets, compartment warning lights, battery gauge, SCBA seat mount, rear seat occupancy sensors and engine belt squeal; a repair plan was agreed upon.
 - b. Engine-83: ladder rack hydraulic power arms being replaced, along with other maintenance items (Engine 82 was assigned in its place while being serviced);
 - c. Tender-82: new tires ordered and installed; and
 - d. Brush-81: new tires ordered, to be installed.
- 2) Facilities:
 - a. Emergency power generators at firestations: updating preventative maintenance plan and working on fuel delivery program;
 - b. Station 8-3: a new utility sink is being installed as part of the personal protective equipment decontamination program, located in the Annex Building.
 - c. Station 8-3: building fire sprinkler pump is leaking, and Lt Hall has contacted Knight Fire for repairs and testing.
 - d. Lt Hall conducted further investigation of propane usage in the District substations as part of the ongoing review of utility consumption and cost. Regular reporting of utility usage is being planned as a regular reporting measure.
 - e. Lt Hall reported on the water supply leak behind Station 8-3: the leak was located at a joint of two 20-ft long PVC pipes, bent from flexing caused by heavy vehicle traffic above. The joint has been temporarily repaired, however, a permanent solution is being sought, which will probably include deeper burying of the supply pipe.
 - f. District facility keys have been re-inventoried and some new keys issued as authorized by the Fire Chief. Lt Hall is "keeper of the keys".

- g. Community use of District meeting rooms: on-duty IR&R staff have been reminded to check the room and public entry ways after each use to ensure the rooms are clean and doors are secured.
